



Introducing Saruni Rhino & Black Rhino Tracking Experience



Opened February 2017

Sera Community Conservancy, Northern Kenya

In February 2017, Saruni was proud to expand its luxury collection of lodges and tented camps with the opening of 'Saruni Rhino'. Located in Sera Conservancy, in the wild, undiscovered northern frontier of Kenya, the intimate camp is a 2 hours' drive away from our Saruni Samburu lodge in nearby Kalama Conservancy. Saruni Rhino offers the first rhino tracking experience in East Africa, an amazing experience that provides a uniquely thrilling experience, but also allows our guests to actively contribute to the protection of this iconic species.

Comprised of two elegant 'bandas' (open stone cottages) sleeping 4-6 initially and a main 'mess' cottage for dining and relaxing, Saruni Rhino is nestled amidst swaying doum palms dotted along a dry river bed (the Kauro 'lugga', in the heart of the conservancy) with sweeping views of a nearby waterhole and dramatic landscape so typical of the north. The waterhole is a popular watering stop-off for a diverse range of wildlife: elephant, impala, birdlife, hyena, oryx, Grevy's zebra and much more, making it great 'bush TV' from the comfort of your cottage's sandy verandah at any time. The dry river bed proves the quintessential torch-lit bush dinner location under the vast African skies. Whilst staying at Saruni Rhino is an experience in itself; echoing the origins of safari – exploring remote areas of a yet largely undiscovered terrain, the main draw to the area is the reason for our camp's name sake – the Rhino.

This price does not include all-inclusive accommodation at Saruni Samburu and Saruni Rhino. Current per person per night rates apply. A 2 nights' minimum stay at Saruni Rhino combined with a 2 nights' minimum stay at Saruni Samburu is required. Cost of the Rhino Tracking Experience is per person per 1 x early morning or 1 x late afternoon tracking session. Additional rhino tracking sessions are payable extra.

*The Rhino Tracking Experience is only available to guests over 16 years of age. Children under the age of 16 years can stay at Saruni Rhino paying the current Saruni child's rate and the conservation fee but due to safety reasons will not be permitted to participate in the Rhino Tracking Experience. Single rate supplement applies.
